- Kindergarten students need to have their physical and immunization forms in on Thursday, August 5th. Please call the office if you have questions regarding immunizations or are unable to obtain the forms on-line.

- You may remember that it has been requested that all of the fees be paid to the school by the end of final registration on August 5th. We suggest that you consider using Capital City Bank to complete payment if you are unable to have the fees paid in full. So, representatives of Capital City Bank will be available at final registration for those who wish to pay their fees monthly. Balances must be financed through Capital City Bank. Please contact Mrs. Hillebert if you have questions.
- Make sure that you pick up the Handbook, on August 5th! It will contain forms for you family. These forms are to be completed and returned on or before the first day of school.
- If you are unable to attend the final registration on August 5th please contact the office now to find out how to arrange to complete your child(rens) enrollment at a later date.
