

In the visual arts, composition is the placement or arrangement of visual elements or 'ingredients' in a work of art, as distinct from the subject. It can also be thought of as the organization of the elements of art according to the principles of art.

Elements of Art

These are the basic elements that are used by artists in creating art; they are what you use to create an aesthetically pleasing work.

-Line - a moving point

-Shape - geometric or organic; 2-D
(2 dimensional)

-Color - hue, value and intensity

-Value - degrees of lightness

-Form - objects that are 3-D
(3 dimensional)

-Texture - describes the feel of a surface

-Space - is used to create the illusion of depth; space can be 2D, 3D, negative and/or positive
